The application form asks for the information the Northern Ireland Environment Agency (NIEA) needs to decide if your activity can be registered as exempt from waste management licensing. If you fill in the form accurately, NIEA will be able to deal with your application quicker.

When you make the application make sure you:

1. Answer all the questions that apply to you. If any of the questions do not apply, write 'Not applicable' on the application form. If you leave anything out NIEA may return your application.
2. Send the correct fee with your application form. For details of fees, see the accompanying 'Fees and charges' document.
3. Use black ink to complete the application form and ensure that you write clearly inside the boxes.
4. Do not use correction fluid. If you do need to make a change, cross out and initial the original entry and enter the amendment. NIEA will treat illegible or indeterminate entries as being invalid and you will not be registered to undertake the exempt activity. Should you proceed without the relevant registration you will run the risk of enforcement action.

Your application for a new registration **must** reach NIEA **at least 28 days** before the date you intend to commence the exempt activity, or, in the case of a renewal, **28 days** before the existing registration expires.
