Guidance Notes

1. In the case of a partnership, each partner must sign the application form. Only one fee is required for a partnership.
- 2.(i) Details of an offence listed in the Controlled Waste (Registration of Carriers and Seizure of Vehicles) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999 must be given if the applicant was convicted of the offence or if the person convicted of the offence (“the relevant person”)-
 - (a) committed it in the course of his employment by the applicant;
 - (b) committed it in the course of the carrying on of any business by a partnership, one of the members of which was the applicant;
 - (c) was a body corporate and at the time when the offence was committed the applicant was a director, manager, secretary or other similar officer of that body;
 - (d) was a director, manager, secretary or other similar officer of the applicant (where the applicant is a body corporate);
 - (e) was a body corporate and at the time when the offence was committed a director, manager, secretary or other similar officer of the applicant held such an office in the body corporate which committed the offence.
- 2.(ii) Details of a conviction need not be given where under the terms of the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 the conviction is spent.

- 4.(i) Details of all vehicles to be used for the purpose of transporting controlled waste in connection with the Registration of Carriers should be provided in Section C.
 - (ii) Details in the change of ownership or purchasing of new or additional vehicles should be forwarded immediately to this Department in writing.
 - (iii) Identification documents showing the companies details and Vehicle Registration Mark will be issued for every vehicle registered and should be carried in the vehicle at all times. **Under Article 42(3) of the Waste and Contaminated Land (NI) Order 1997** an authorised officer of the Department may require a person when stopped to show his authority for transporting controlled waste where he believes there may be a contravention of Articles 38(1).
 - (iv) The identification documents remain the property of the Department at all times and should be returned on request or on disposal of the vehicle.
- 5.(i) Where appropriate the fee of £120.00 must be sent with the application, otherwise the Department will refuse to accept the application.
 - (ii) Cheques must be made payable to the **Department of the Environment** and crossed "**A/C Payee**".
 - (iii) Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be accepted.
 - (iv) Completed applications should be sent to the address listed below.
